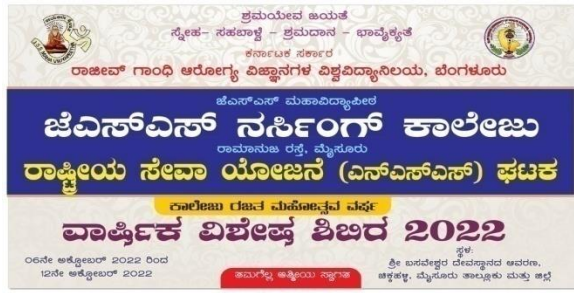

**ABOUT ANNUAL NSS SPECIAL CAMP 2022**

NSS Unit of JSS College of Nursing, Mysuru conducted NSS Annual Special Camp for 7 days at Chikkahalli village, Mysuru (T&D) with the theme “**Healthy India, Strong India**” from **06.10.2022 to 12.10.2022**. The purpose of the camp addressed the common health issues among the villagers such as, Prevention and Management of Hypertension and Diabetes Mellitus, Environmental Sanitation, Personal Hygiene, Women and Child Health. **Lecture sessions** organized on various topics for villagers and volunteers like Importance of Health, Role of Youth on Rural Development, Religious beliefs and practices, Basic rights, Law and order, Prevention of diseases, Importance of Nutrition for mothers & children, First aid treatment, Prevention and Management of Malnutrition among under-five children, measures for common minor ailments, yoga & its health benefits



The camp also organized and conducted activities on special issues like Health promotion of school children, Women and old age. **Swachatha Programmes** conducted at Govt. Higher primary school, cleaning of drainage and roads of Chikkahalli. Organized and conducted **Arogya Jagruthi Jatha** rally on prevention and management of Tuberculosis and Diabetes Mellitus.

Health exhibition was organized on Safe Motherhood, Prevention & Management of Diabetes, Hypertension, Anemia and Protein Energy Malnutrition. Other special features of the camp were ‘**Free Health check up camps (General Health, Dental, Ophthalmology, and Child Health)**’ conducted, free drugs were distributed.

About 1500 people got benefitted from free health check up services was facilitated by NSS Unit of JSS College of Nursing. Totally, we rendered a bunch of health services with Cultural Programmes to Chikkahalli Village.

## **INAUGURAL CEREMONY OF NSS SPECIAL CAMP OCTOBER 2022**

NSS Unit of JSS College of Nursing conducted the inaugural programme for special annual NSS camp on 06.10.2022. ### GENERAL HEALTH CHECK UP

In Collaboration with JSS hospital, we organized a general health camp. Dr. Rahul and Dr. Sujith participated in the camp from JSS Hospital. More than 150 rural elderly people were screened and treated for minor ailments. Free drugs were distributed to villagers who were diagnosed with minor health problem. Mean while we organized health exhibition on diabetic mellitus and hypertension. This ended successfully at 1:30pm with appreciation from village leaders.





At 2.30pm, we organized brain storming memory games for NSS Volunteers and then winded up the games at 4:00pm.

They examined 100 villagers and suggested treatment for their eye problems. They distributed complimentary eye medication and also screened out people for matured Cataract. By 1:00 pm, we ended the camp.

They assessed nearly 120 children and identified many chronic problems in them. Malnutrition is a major public health problem found in the village. Then we held meetings with the parents of these children, given medication and health education. Health exhibition was organized from 9.00 am to 1.00 pm on 'Children health problems and Personal hygiene'. The programme ended by 1.00 pm.



Forenoon at 3.00 pm, we organized and conducted 'Pick and Act' programme, all the NSS volunteers participated and exhibited their talent.
