JSS College of Nursing

Various health surveys brought to light the fact that the strength of nursing staff in all the fields of health needs to be increased appreciably. The high power committee on 'Nursing and Nursing Profession' set up by the Central Government gave its recommendations at the end of March 1990. One of the recommendations was that the nursing education needs to be fitted into the national stream of education to bring about uniformity, recognition and standards.

The committee recommends that there should be two levels of Nursing Personnel viz., Professional Nurse (Degree level) and Auxiliary Nurse/Vocational Nurse (Plus two level). This is the internationally accepted pattern of nursing education.




The JSS College of Nursing was started in November 1997 by the foresight and vision of His Holiness Jagadguru Sri Shivarathreeshwara Deshikendra Mahaswamiji to prepare professional nurses at the university level, in order to improve standards of nursing service through quality nursing education. years. This is the first college of nursing started in the city of Mysuru. It is also the first college of nursing in Mysuru to start a post graduation course in nursing. 

It recognizes national health goals and is committed to participate in the implementation of National Health Policies and Programmes. It believes in identifying health needs of the people, planning and providing quality healthcare in collaboration with other health professionals and community groups. The scope of nursing includes prevention of diseases, promotion of health in individuals, families and community and the care of sick, injured and infirm in the hospital and/or community. We also view that the concept of comprehensive nursing includes care during wellness, illness and rehabilitation; guiding and teaching the patient and family regarding continued care, recovery and maintenance of health.

The faculty believes that nursing education is based upon an understanding of man, derived from the knowledge of humanities, psychological, social, biological and physical sciences. Nursing is based on values of caring and aims to help individuals to attain independence in self care. It necessitates development of compassion and understanding of human behavior among the practitioners to provide care with respect, dignity and protect the rights of individuals and groups.

The faculty accepts the fact that undergraduate nursing programme is broad-based education within an academic framework specifically directed to the development of critical thinking skills, competencies & standards required for practice of professional nursing and midwifery as envisaged in the National Health Policy 2002. The faculty also accepts and appreciates that the teachers have the responsibility to be role models and create a learning environment that enables students to acquire inquisitiveness driven, self directed learning and fosters an attitude of lifelong learning. The faculty is also responsible for preparing better qualified nurses to assume the responsibilities of providing holistic patient care at various levels in different healthcare settings. The teachers must also be prepared to improve their knowledge and skills through channels of higher education.

The undergraduate nursing education program will also prepare its graduates to become exemplary citizens by adhering to code of ethics and professional conduct at all times in fulfilling personal, social and professional obligations, so as to respond to national aspirations.

The faculty further believes that the Master of Nursing Programme built upon a recognized Bachelor's Curriculum in Nursing (recognized by Indian Nursing Council), prepares nurses for leadership position in nursing and health fields, who can function as specialist nurse practitioners, consultants, educationists, administrators and investigators in a wide variety of professional settings in meeting the national priorities and the changing needs of the society. JSS Nursing College conducts a large number of workshops and seminars every year with a view to further advance the nursing profession and give our students a sound exposure. We regularly conduct state level workshops and a national workshop every alternative year, in which a minimum of 5 to 6 states partake. The college also regularly publishes an e-journal (once in four months).

The faculty of the college has a strong orientation to research. Every member of the faculty is involved in projects and they regularly publish research papers in peer reviewed journals.

Courses

The college is affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences (RGHUS), Bengaluru, and recognized by Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi, and Karnataka State Nursing Council, Bengaluru. The University ordinance for the Bachelor of Nursing course (Basic and Post Basic) and M.Sc. Nursing mentions the admission requirements, program of study and the examination scheme and the same is followed by this college.

Course 1: Bachelor of Science in Nursing (Basic)

Duration: 4 years

Eligibility Criteria of Admission

The candidate seeking admission must:

- a. have passed Pre-university examination (PUC of 2 years) or equivalent as recognized by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences with science subjects, viz., Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English
- b. have obtained at least fifty percent (50%) of the total marks in science subjects (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) & English in case of General Category and 40% in case of SC/ST
- c. have completed 17 years on or before 31st of December of the year of admission
- d. be medically fit (should produce a medical fitness certificate from a recognized and licensed Physician)

Course 2: Bachelor of Science in Nursing (Post Basic)

Duration: 2 years

Eligibility Criteria for Admission

The candidate seeking admission must:

- a. hold a Diploma in General Nursing & Midwifery (GNM)
- b. be a registered nurse and midwife
- c. have passed pre-university examination in the Arts/Science/Commerce conducted by the Department of Pre University Education, Karnataka State or its equivalent as recognized by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences
- d. be medically fit (should produce a medical fitness certificate from a recognized and licensed physician)
- e. have a good personal and professional record
- f. have working knowledge of English
- g. be within 45 years of age as on 31st December of the year of admission

The candidate seeking admission must have:

- a. passed B.Sc. Nursing (Basic) or Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing Degree or Post Certificate B.Sc. Nursing of Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences (RGUHS), Karnataka, or any other university accepted as equivalent by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka, and must have obtained a minimum of not less than 55% aggregate marks. In respect of candidates belonging to scheduled caste and scheduled tribe, the aggregate marks obtained should not be less than 50% instead of 55% as above
- b. a minimum of 1 year of experience after obtaining B.Sc. Nursing (Basic) or minimum of one year of work experience prior or after Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing Degree or Post Certificate B.Sc. Nursing in a hospital or a nursing educational institution, which is recognized by Indian Nursing Council
- c. registered in State Nursing Council as a Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife.

Hostel Accommodation

Hostel is compulsorily provided for Basic B.Sc. Nursing students. For students of other courses, hostel accommodation is available on demand (only for girls). Boys of all the courses can avail the hostel facility at JSS Medical College Boys' Hostel, which is located at a distance of 8 km from the college.

A written permission from the Principal is required for staying out of the hostel after the regular permitted hours and while leaving station (Mysuru).


- Those students who do not follow the rules & regulations of the hostel will be liable for dismissal from the hostel.

6. Counseling and Guidance


Personal problems of students are looked into and necessary counseling and guidance is provided to them by the college faculty.

ANTI-RAGGING POLICY

1. Preamble

JSS College of Nursing, Mysuru, is committed to fostering a safe, inclusive, and respectful environment for all its students. Ragging and bullying are strictly prohibited and are considered grave offenses that undermine the dignity and well-being of individuals. This policy outlines the college's zero-tolerance stance against ragging and bullying, establishes the Anti-Ragging and Anti-Bullying Committee, and defines its roles, responsibilities, and the procedures for prevention, prohibition, and redressal in accordance with statutory regulations.

2. Objectives

The objectives of this Anti-Ragging and Anti-Bullying Policy are to:

- Prohibit any act of ragging or bullying, whether physical, psychological, or emotional.
- Prevent the occurrence of ragging and bullying incidents within the college premises, hostels, and any place where students gather for academic or co-curricular activities.
- Ensure prompt and fair investigation of all reported incidents of ragging and bullying.
- Take strict disciplinary action against individuals found guilty of ragging or bullying.
- Promote a culture of mutual respect, understanding, and camaraderie among students.
- Comply with all relevant statutory provisions and regulations concerning ragging.

4. Anti-Ragging and Anti-Bullying Committee (ARABC)

The Anti-Ragging and Anti-Bullying Committee shall be constituted annually and will comprise members from various stakeholders to ensure a broad representation and effective functioning.

Admission Requirements in case of Foreign Students

2. A clearance certificate issued by the Ministry of Human Resources Development, Government of India, New Delhi
3. Student Visa/Long-term Visa

Candidates are also required to enclose the photocopies as indicated in the application form.


Please Note:

Screening for Foreign Students for HIV
